1931 Cadillac V-16 Phaeton Set for Dallas Auction

TULSA, Okla. (October 28, 2009) — A CCA classic 1931 Cadillac V-16 Phaeton will be auctioned at the 37th annual Dallas Leake Collector Car Show & Auction, November 20-22 in Market Hall. The Cadillac features matching numbers on its engine, chassis and body per its original construction. The tan broadcloth upholstery and tan cloth top, piped in brown, are indicative of the quality and features that have made Cadillac the standard of excellence in classic cars.

“This is a beautiful Cadillac,” said Richard Sevenoaks, president of Leake Auction Company. “A Cadillac of this caliber rarely comes up for auction. We anticipate a lot of interest in this car, especially among Cadillac enthusiasts.”

A unique 1954 Buick Skylark Sport Convertible was recently added to the auction’s line-up. Fully restored, the Skylark boasts a 322 CI V-8 engine, dynaflo automatic transmission and big chrome fins. The black Skylark features red leather interior.

The 37th annual Leake Collector Car Show and Auction will take place November 20-22 in Market Hall. Admission is \$10 for adults and \$5 for children. Doors open at 9am daily. 500 cars are anticipated.
