Former NASCAR Cars Consigned to Leake Auction

TULSA, Okla. (May 27, 2010) — Leake Auction Company just consigned Richard Petty's NASCAR "Farewell Tour Car." The Pontiac Grand Prix Race Car was raced and restored by Richard Petty. The car will be sold during the 38th Annual Leake Collector Car Show & Auction in the Tulsa QuikTrip Center, June 11-13. Doors will open at 9am daily and admission is only \$15 for adults and \$7 for children.

The "Tide Ride" Monte Carlo, raced by Travis Kvapil, will also be auctioned. Equipped with a 358 CI / 800 HP NASCAR RCR V-8 engine, the car has been raced at the Kansas Speedway, Pocono Raceway and Talladega Superspeedway. Other race cars include a 1987 March Cosworth Formula One, Chassis #4, raced by Al Unser, and Ernie Irvan's 1991 Chevrolet Lumina the 1991 Daytona 500 winner. It is known as "Willard" in the racing community.

A 1969 Chevrolet Camaro Pro Touring Show car has also been entered in the Auction. After a complete restoration, the Camaro is equipped with a 383 CI V-8 Stroker engine, with a custom built 700R4 automatic transmission and a new drivetrain.

Also on the auction block is a 1971 Plymouth Custom Hemi Cuda. It features a 472 CI V-8 engine with 4-speed manual transmission and Coys custom wheels.

"We have some really great race cars with lots of history in this year's Tulsa sale. It will be a wonderful opportunity to see them up close. We are seeing an increasing trend towards pro touring cars," stated Richard Sevenoaks, president of Leake Auction Company. "People are purchasing these pro touring cars and equipping them with new engines, tires and the latest technology."
